Directions

From New York City and Southern Westchester via the New England Thruway (95 North): Take Exit 21 (Cross-Westchester Expressway) to first exit (Exit 9). At first light, turn left onto Kenilworth Road. At next light, turn left onto Westchester Ave. and follow Route 120 (Rye) to the Club entrance.

From New York City and Southern Westchester via the Hutchinson River Parkway (North): Take Exit 25 (North St., Harrison) – make right off of exit. Go through first light; Club entrance is less than 1 mile away.

From Rockland County and New Jersey: Take the Tappan Zee Bridge to Route 287 East to Exit 10. As you exit, bear right to Route 120, Rye. At light, make right; Club is on your left, 500 feet further.

From Connecticut via the New England Thruway (95 South): Take 95 South to 287 West (Cross-Westchester Expressway) to first exit (Exit 9). At first light, turn left onto Kenilworth Road. At next light, turn left onto Westchester Ave. and follow Route 120 (Rye) to the Club entrance.

From Northern Westchester and Connecticut via 684: Take 684 South to Route 287 East to Exit 10. As you exit, stay to the right and follow Route 120 to the Club entrance.
